INFORMATION NOTE ON CEOS OPEN FORUM ON AGRICULTURAL AND RURAL FINANCE

1. BACKGROUND

Recently the stagnation of agricultural production is witnessed possibly as the result of the weakened investment in agriculture by the Governments for decades.
