Agricultural Value Chain Financing Support and Capacity Building thru Entrepreneurship and Organizational Development (Project ASCEnD)

Objectives

- 1 Demonstrate viability and promote adoption of agri-value chain financing (AVCF) by non-bank rural financial institutions (NBRFIs)
- 2 To determine and provide the capacity building requirements of a NBRFI engaged in AVCF
- 3 Develop relevant tools that could be used by NBRFIs to engage in AVCF
- Strengthen farmers and fisherfolk cooperatives/organizations especially their capacity to manage funds and provide AVCF and improve the capacity of farmers and fishers to effectively engage in the agri-value chain
- Provide useful information in the formulation of relevant and appropriate policies and government interventions that support and encourage NBRFIs to engage in AVCF


