Course Objectives

The five-day regional course aims to **strengthen the institutional and technical capacity of CLMV to mobilise, access, and effectively utilise climate finance for advancing safe, resilient, and inclusive agri-food systems aligned with regional and global frameworks for climate action and sustainable development.**

1. Increase understanding of the global, regional, and national climate finance architecture and its relevance to agri-food systems transformation and food safety;
2. Equip participants to analyse climate risks, vulnerabilities, and priority areas for investment in agri-food systems, and align them with national adaptation plans (NAPs), nationally determined contributions (NDCs), and regional policy frameworks;
3. Strengthen the ability to apply risk financing and insurance tools that protect smallholder farmers and value chain actors from climate-induced losses;
4. Strengthen the capacity of participant in mainstreaming gender equality, social inclusion, and environmental and social safeguards into climate finance projects; and
5. Support participants in developing actionable country-specific roadmaps that enhance institutional readiness, coordination, policy alignment, and access to climate finance.

Mid- to senior-level professionals with decision-making or technical responsibilities in climate, finance, or agri-food programs from:

1. Ministries of Agriculture, Environment, Finance, Planning, and Commerce
2. Agricultural and development banks, insurance agencies, and and microfinance institutions
3. NGOs and community-based organisations promoting inclusive and resilient food systems, including networks and associations
